

Minutes of Fluvanna Electoral Board meeting on 5/8/20

We were called to order at 10:30 AM. Catherine Hobbs, Patricia Hastings and Dan Graff were in attendance along with the Registrar Joyce Pace. Frances Schutz attended as a League of Women Voters representative.

We reviewed Logic and Accuracy (L&A) Testing scheduling and execution requirements for the June Dual Primary. We scheduled L&A Testing for Wednesday, May 13, 2020 at 9:00 at the Old Courthouse.

We reviewed Officer of Elections (OE) availability for the June Dual Primary.

We reviewed the use of online training for OEs. Most OEs that indicated they are available to support the June Primary could participate in online training. Chiefs, Assistant Chiefs and Admins may be included in onsite training.

We reviewed the need to maintain sanitary polling places and will look for guidance from the local health department. We also looked at additional polling place procedures to protect both OEs and voters. We will request that Fluvanna County provide three plexiglass sneeze guards per precinct.

We discussed the possible impact of a reduction in restrictions by the governor to training and election operations.

In person training must be done on or after June 10th and will probably be done on Saturday June 13th. We will conduct this training in multiple small group sessions for Chiefs, Asst Chiefs, Admins and first time Officers of Election.

We discussed how we can encourage Absentee Voting for the June Primary.

We agreed to meet at 11:15 AM on June 15, 2020 to review the Fluvanna County Elections Security Plan.

Catherine Hobbs motioned to adjourn at 12:45 PM. Dan Graff seconded. The session adjourned.
